Heartfelt Help Foundation ensures that heart transplant patients can recover financially while they heal physically. We're a 501(c)3 micro-nonprofit organization that supports financially challenged heart transplant recipients in Northern California through five programs, two providing financial aid and three for mentoring.

Recovery Lodging

We help pay for medically required temporary recovery lodging near the hospital when insurance doesn't cover it and patients or parents of pediatric patients can't afford it.

Helping Hand

We help pay for essential medical and non-medical expenses that become unaffordable because of the transplant (such as loss of income). Support could be rent or mortgage, utilities, car payment or repair, medications, deductibles or copays, medical travel, or groceries.

Beyond the Heart

We formed a parent-led, therapist-moderated support group for parents of pediatric heart transplant patients who are experiencing complex recoveries or grieving the loss of their child.

Peer-to-Peer

We mentor adult heart transplant patients, parents of pediatric patients, and caregivers from our firsthand experience to help them navigate life after the transplant and to maximize the gift.

Financial Coaching

We offer coaching by licensed financial professionals who volunteer to guide people into stability through basic money management.
